**SOC Code** – Six-digit numerical code assigned to the occupation under the Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) system. The SOC system classifies all occupations found in the economy, including private, public, and military, and allows data to be compared across all governmental agencies.

**Occupation** – Occupational title assigned under the SOC system for the given occupational code. In some instances, this may be abbreviated from the official SOC title.

**Occup. Group** – Job categories for occupations with similar job duties and education/training requirements.

**Educational Attainment** – Minimum education and/or training level required for workers in the given occupation, based on findings from the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS).

**Short-term or Moderate-term training (ST OJT or MT OJT)** – basic tasks and skills are learned through a period of on-the-job training. A high school diploma may be required.

**Long-term training (LT OJT)** – a high school diploma and at least one year of on-the-job training or an apprenticeship.

**Related work experience (WK EXP)** – a high school diploma and training gained through hands-on work in a similar occupation.

**Postsecondary training (PS or PS+)** – training is gained through a postsecondary training program. Some period of related work experience may be required.

**Associate Degree (AD or AD+)** – degree completed after two years of full-time schooling beyond high school. Some period of related work experience may be required.

**Bachelor's Degree (BD or BD+)** – degree completed after four years of full-time schooling beyond high school. Some period of related work experience may be required.

**Master's Degree (MD or MD+)** – degree completed after two years of full-time schooling beyond a bachelor's degree. Some period of related work experience may be required.

**Doctoral (PhD) or First Professional Degree (PROF)** – degree programs requiring 3-6 years of education at the college or university level beyond a four-year bachelor's degree.

**Annual Average Wage** – Average annual wage, in dollars, for the given occupation across all industries as calculated from the employer data collected in the May 2012 panel of the Occupational Employment Statistics (OES) survey. Wages are straight-time gross pay, exclusive of premium pay and benefits.

**Annual Openings** – Estimated number of total annual job today expert soccer predictions openings due to growth and replacement needs that are expected for the given occupation across all industries. Data are based on the 2010-20 Long-Term Occupational Employment Projections.

**Dominant Industry Cluster(s)** – Industry cluster(s) in which the occupation meets all criteria to be an HPO.
